
# BADI HOSTED LUNCHEON IN OUR OFFICES WITH BUSINESSES AND STAKEHOLDERS ATTENDING



Once a month Canberra Innovation Network hosts an energetic event, called Wednesday Connect that is attended by investors, innovators, researchers and entrepreneurs.

### **THE EVENT - IN CANBERRA CITY**

A get-together where business people get their turn on stage to enthusiastically pitch their business idea in 60 seconds to all the movers and shakers in attendance in the hopes of attracting an investor or collaborator. There's plenty of time afterwards to meet like minded new associates with drinks and snacks.

The ACT Microcredit Loan Program provides ACT residents on a low income with interest free or low interest loans to help them start or expand an existing business.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR INTEREST FREE LOAN UP TO \$3,000

A Health Care Card (for at least 6 months), Pension Card or equivalent. A combined family income no higher than \$65,000.

An ACT resident of at least six months. Setting up a business in the ACT Unable to get finance for your business or business idea from typical financial services.

A Health Care Card (for at least 6 months), Pension Card or equivalent. A combined family income no higher than \$75,000.

An ACT resident at least 6 months. An existing or semi established business in the ACT. Unable to get finance from typical financial services.

It's designed to offer early stage innovative entrepreneurs and startups matched-funded grants between \$10,000 -\$30,000 to kick start their growth journey. CSIRO's program to help start-ups and small businesses overcome funding and lack of technical expertise barriers when trying to research and develop new ideas.
