

In the first week of December 2024, two Badji participants showcased their businesses at the 2024 NACCHO Members' Conference.

The Conference saw 900 delegates with 104 presenters covering 65 unique topics. There were four Federal

Government Ministers/Assistant Minister, 21 CEO's, 39 Front Line Workers, 16 Educational and Research Employees, with two Government Departments represented throughout the presentations and 58 participating organisations representing every State and Territory within Australia.

11 February 2025


Female Founders aims to support womenled businesses and promote female entrepreneurship and is designed to address the under-representation of women in the startup arena.


